PREK –3 REQUIREMENTS

Child must be three on or before Sept. 1, 2009 and one of the following:

1. is unable to speak and comprehend the English language;(to be determined by LEP criteria)
2. is educationally disadvantaged. “Educationally disadvantaged” prekindergarten students are defined by the Agency as students eligible to participate in the national free or reduced-price lunch program;
3. is homeless, as defined by 42 U.S.C. Section 11302;
4. is the child of an active duty member of the armed forces of the U.S., including the state military forces or a reserve component of the armed forces, who is ordered to active duty by proper authority;
5. is the child of a member of the armed forces of the U.S., including the state military forces or a reserve component of the armed forces, who was injured or killed while serving on active duty;
- or
6. is or ever has been in the conservatorship of the Department of Family Protective Services following an adversary hearing held as provided by Section 262.201, Family Code.

PREK – 4 REQUIREMENTS

Child must be four on or before Sept. 1, 2009 and one of the following:

7. is unable to speak and comprehend the English language;(to be determined by LEP criteria)
8. is educationally disadvantaged. “Educationally disadvantaged” prekindergarten students are defined by the Agency as students eligible to participate in the national free or reduced-price lunch program;
9. is homeless, as defined by 42 U.S.C. Section 11302;
10. is the child of an active duty member of the armed forces of the U.S., including the state military forces or a reserve component of the armed forces, who is ordered to active duty by proper authority;
11. is the child of a member of the armed forces of the U.S., including the state military forces or a reserve component of the armed forces, who was injured or killed while serving on active duty;
- or
12. is or ever has been in the conservatorship of the Department of Family Protective Services following an adversary hearing held as provided by Section 262.201, Family Code.

Prekindergarten Programs for Children with Disabilities

Children with disabilities who are at least three years of age are eligible to participate in school district special education programs. Texas Education Code, Section 29.009 requires school districts to notify parents or guardians of children with disabilities of the availability of preschool programs for these children.
